Mission Statement or Philosophy: Our mission is to provide an outstanding Catholic education for students in Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 8. Based on the teachings of Jesus, the school strives to inspire the whole child by promoting an educational philosophy characterized by charity, respect and outreach. Our students are challenged to fully explore their talents and to live in a complex world as true Disciples of Christ.

School History: Christ Our King-Stella Maris School was established in 1950 by Father John McLaughlin. The school, first named Stella Maris School, was established on Sullivan's Island and was staffed by the Sisters of Charity of Our Lady of Mercy. In 1953 the school moved to Russell Drive in Mount Pleasant. The school grew rapidly and additions were added to the building in both 1957 and 1963. The school was renamed Christ Our King-Stella Maris School in 1973. Christ Our King-Stella Maris School was damaged in 1989 by Hurricane Hugo. Using hurricane insurance settlement as seed money, a \$3 million campaign was begun to update the school. In 1996 the original building was renovated to a two story structure housing three classrooms for each grade. The final addition of the school gym and auditorium was completed in 1999. Christ Our King-Stella Maris School currently enrolls over 600 students. It is accredited by Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, it is National Blue Ribbon School and our middle school became a certified International Baccalaureate program in 2011.
