School expansion project approved. September 2002 Seventh grade is added. Enrollment continues to grow. June 2002-Construction of new classroom and science lab completed. February 16, 2003 Bishop Baker blesses new classrooms and 800 sq. ft. science lab during dedication ceremony. September 2003 Eighth grade is added. Enrollment continues to grow. September 2004 Duffy Center opens and is named after our beloved Monsignor Thomas R. Duffy August 2005 Hanley Hall is renovated and becomes Hanley Library and Media Center April 1 2006 School and church website is launched! Oct. 2006 —WELCOME CHOMPY Our New School Mascot Aug. 2008-St. Michael Catholic School and Church breaks ground on the new Gator Field. Sept. 20, 2008-Our new GATOR FIELD is blessed by Father Ray. March 2009-Msgr. Robert Guglielmone, named new Bishop of Charleston. July 2013-Shauna L. Schubiger relocates to SC from NJ and becomes our new principal.
